Ordinance no 1

An ordinance providing for a bond to be given by the Town Clerk, and fixing the Amount and Conditions of said bond.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Couperville, Washington:
That the Town Clerk of the town of Couperville, Washington, shall execute and deliver to said town of Couperville, Washington, a bond in the sum of \$100.00, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties as such clerk, and the turning over to the treasurer of said town of Couperville, all moneys collected or received by him as such clerk for said town.
