

ORDINANCE NO. 102

An Ordinance of the Town of Coupeville, regulating the Speed of Vehicles over streets of the Town and Fixing Penalties for the Violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Coupeville Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The state traffic laws regulating the speed of vehicles shall be applicable upon all streets within this town, except as this Ordinance, as authorized by state law, hereby declares and determines that certain speed regulations shall be applicable upon specified streets or in certain areas, in which event it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of any speed so declared in this Ordinance when signs are in place giving notice thereof.

Section 2. It is hereby determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed permitted by state law upon the following streets is less than is necessary for safe operation of vehicles thereon by reason of the designation and sign posting of said streets as arterial highways and by reason of widely spaced intersections and it is hereby declared that the speed limit shall be as hereinafter set forth on these streets or parts of streets herein designated at the time specified when signs are erected giving notice thereof, but in no case shall the speed limit exceed thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

Those portions of East Prairie, Main, Cove, Race and Glenwood streets and any other streets comprising State Highway 1-D over its entire route within the Town limits shall have

as a speed limit as posted, but in no event to exceed thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

Section 3. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by law, every person convicted of violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be punished by fine of not more than \$100. or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days or by both fine and imprisonment.
