

ORDINANCE NO. 107

An Ordinance of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, declaring that there exists a public emergency of the character enumerated in N E C W Section 35.33.080 and appropriating the sum of \$5,000.00 and authorizing the immediate expenditure of said sum for the maintenance and resurfacing of the streets of the Town of Coupeville.

THE TOWN COUNCIL of the Town of Coupeville does ordain as follows:

Section A.

That Whereas an emergency exists that affects the welfare of the population of the Town of Coupeville, in that due to the extreme cold last winter it has become necessary to resurface the perform extensive repairs to the streets of the Town of Coupeville, and that it is necessary that such work be done to adequately serve the needs of the citizens of the Town of Coupeville, and that additional funds in the amount of \$5000.00 are necessary to pay the expenses thereof for the balance of the fiscal year of 1956, that necessity of such said expenditures could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of the budget for the fiscal year of 1956.

Section II

Town Council, of the Town of Coupeville, does hereby find that an emergency exists for the appropriation of \$5000 to be used for said purposes and there is hereby appropriated for the purposes of resurfacing, regrading, and maintaining the streets of the Town of Coupeville, the sum of \$5000.00. It is further ordained that the sum of \$5000.00 be transferred from the cumulative sewer fund as a loan from said fund to be repaid to that fund without interest during the fiscal year of 1957.

SECTION III

THAT a public hearing will be held on the passage of this ordinance at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m. on the 8th day of October, 1956, at the regular meeting place of the Town Council of the Town of Coupeville, at which time and place any tax payer may appear and be heard for or against the expenditure of money, for said emergency.
