

1 An Ordinance of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, declaring that
2 there exists a public emergency of the character enumerated in R C W
3 Section 35.33.080 and appropriating the sum of \$10,320.63, and authoriz-
4 ing the immediate expenditure of said sum for the maintenance and resur-
5 facing of the streets of the Town of Coupeville.

6 TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

7 SECTION I.

8 THAT WHEREAS an emergency exists that effects the welfare of the pop-
9 ulation of the Town of Coupeville, in that due to the extreme cold last
10 winter it has become necessary to resurface and perform extensive repairs
11 to the streets of the Town of Coupeville, and that it is necessary that such
12 work be done to adequately serve the needs of the citizens of the Town of
13 Coupeville, and that additional funds in the amount of \$10,320.63 are nec-
14 essary to pay the expenses thereof for the balance of the fiscal year of
15 1956, that necessity of such said expenditures could not reasonably have
16 been foreseen at the time of the budget for the fiscal year of 1956.

17 SECTION II

18 TOWN COUNCIL, of the Town of Coupeville, does hereby find that an emer-
19 gency exists for the appropriation of \$10,320.63, to be used for said purposes
20 and there is hereby appropriated for the purposes of resurfacing, regrading,
21 and maintaining the streets of the Town of Coupeville, the sum of \$10,320.63.
22 It is further ordained that the sum of \$10,320.63 be transferred from other-
23 wise unappropriated funds to the general street funds for such purposes.

24 This ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
25 health and welfare of the residents and citizens of the Town of Coupeville,
26 and is hereby declared to be in full force and effect immediately.

27 Introduced the 10th day of September, 1956, an emergency declared
28 and this Ordinance passed and approved this 8th day of October, 1956.
