

An Ordinance transferring certain budgeted items in the budget for the Town of Coupeville for 1957, and providing funds with which to hire a second employee.

WHEREAS the Town of Coupeville is about to expand its water system and whereas it is believed that more over-all efficiency would result if the Town would hire another man to take over the operation of the garbage system.

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE:

SECTION I

That there is hereby transferred from funds budgeted for garbage collection cost and operation of the Town dump, the sum of \$ 16.00⁰⁰ for garbage collector salary and \$ 3.00⁰⁰ for garbage collection, maintenance and operation expense.

The items for garbage collection cost and operation of the dump as budgeted, are hereby modified to reduce the item "garbage collection cost" to \$ 350 and "operation of the dump" to \$ 50

SECTION II

There is hereby transferred from the fund for maintenance operation and repairs of the water system the sum of \$ 550⁰⁰ for budgeted item, "wages", under the water fund.
