An Ordinance fixing the salary and fee of the Town Marshal where the same are not otherwise fixed by law and ordinance.

Be it ordained by the council of the Town of Couperville, Washington

1. The marshal shall receive the sum of \$4.00 for each dog shot and buried under the provisions of Ordinance no. 3,

2. The Town Marshal shall receive the sum of \$2.50 per day for all work performed on the streets of Couperville, Washington, the sidewalks thereof, or work performed under the provisions of Ordinance No. 8

3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
