ORDINANCE NO. 120

An ordinance of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, declaring an emergency and authorizing the expenditure of \$ 1125.00 from the water fund.

Be It Ordained by the Town Council of the Ton of Coupeville, Washington, as follows:

1. There is hereby declared an emergency in that since the adoption of the budget for 1956 it has been necessary to issue revenue bonds for extention and improvement of the water system, and that at the time of the adoption of the budget it could not have been forseen that additional interest would have to be paid this year on said bonds. That the sum of \$ 1125.00 is hereby authorized to be spent, in addition to sums already budgeted, for the payment of interest on the water revenue bonds.

PASSED UNANIMOUSLY by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington and approved by its mayor this 14th day of October, 1957.
