Whereas in the year 1956 certain work on the streets was contracted and funds provided therefore, and

Whereas due to delay by the contractors and weather conditions the work was not completed in 1956, and

Whereas at the time of the adoption of the budget for 1957 it was not known that the work would not be completed in 1956,

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE, WASHINGTON,

1. That an emergency does exist that could not have been foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1956 budget.

2. That in addition to other sums budgeted there is hereby authorized to be expended the sum of \$ 5000<sup>00</sup> from the street budget, a portion of these funds to come from the cumulative street fund as previously transferred.

PASSED UNANIMOUSLY by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, and approved by its Mayor this 14th day of October, 1957.
