

ORDINANCE # 128

Ordinance No. ~~108~~<sup>128</sup> and Ordinance of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, declaring an emergency and authorizing the expenditure of \$2,984.00 from the Water fund.

WHEREAS hook-ups have been made to the Water system of the Town of Coupeville faster than anticipated at the time of making last years budget, and

WHEREAS it is necessary to expand the pumping capacity at the Fort Casey pumping station and

WHEREAS it is necessary to purchase additional water meters and other related capital items, and

WHEREAS certain water lines need additional checking for leaks.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, as follows:

That an emergency exists that could not have been foreseen at the time of making the budget for the current year and for the immediate preservation of public health thereis hereby authorized to be expended the sum of \$2,984.00 to meet said emergency and the sum of \$1,334.00 is appropriated for the purchase of a new pump, \$1,000.00 to purchase new water meters and related capital items and \$650.00 for labor to check water lines for leaks.

PASSED unanimously by the Council of the Town of ~~Oak Harbor~~<sup>Coupeville</sup>, Washington and APPROVED by its Mayor this 14th day of July, 1958.
