

Ordinance No. 13.

An Ordinance to prohibit the killing, slaughtering or butchering, hog, cattle or sheep within the town of Couperville, Washington, except by a person for his own family use.

Be it ordained by the council of the Town of Couperville, Washington,

1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to kill, slaughter or butcher, except for his own family use any hog or hogs, cattle or sheep within the town of Couperville, Washington.

2. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$50.00 or imprisoned in the town jail not to exceed 30 Days.

3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval and publication according to law.
