

ORDINANCE NO. 131

An Ordinance of the Town of Coupeville, Washington declaring an emergency and appropriating the sum of \$1,000.00 for the water department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

There is hereby declared an emergency in that due to the increased water consumption the operating expenses of the water system have increased over those predicted at the beginning of the year, new connections having been made to the system faster than anticipated.

There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$300.00 for power, \$100.00 for truck expense, \$200.00 for repair and maintenance, \$200.00 for supplies and \$200.00 for capital outlay, in addition to the sums already budgeted in the water department.

PASSED unaminously by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington and approved by the Mayor this 17th day of November, 1958.
