AN ORDINANCE providing for the annexation of certain territory to the Town of Coupeville and incorporating the same within the corporate limits thereof.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Coupeville as follows:

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the proper authorities of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, signed by the owners of more than seventy-five percent (75%), in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of property, of the hereinafter described area and territory seeking incorporation within the Town limits, and

WHEREAS, thereafter on the 13th day of July, 1959, the Council adopted a resolution fixing the 10th day of August, 1959, at the hour of 9:00 P.M. at the Town Hall in Coupeville as the time and place of the hearing on the petition for annexation of the following described area, and

WHEREAS, Notice of said hearing was published in the Island County Times and was posted in three public places within the hereinafter described area setting forth the time and place of the hearing, and

WHEREAS, after said hearing the Council considers that the best interests would be served by annexing the same to the Town of Coupeville, now therefore,

IT IS ORDAINED AND ORDERED that the following described property, be and the same is hereby annexed to and incorporated into the Town of Coupeville, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast meander corner of Government Lot One (1), Section Thirty-five (35), Township Thirty-two (32) North, Range One (1), East of the Willamette Meridian; thence Southerly to the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northwest quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 35; thence Westerly to the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Thirty-two (32) North, Range One (1), East of the Willamette Meridian; thence North to the meander corner common to Government Lots Two (2) and Three (3) of said Section 34; thence Easterly along the meander line to the point of beginning.

This Ordinance shall take effect after its passage and publication.

Passed by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, and approved by its Mayor this 10th day of August, 1959.
