

Ordinance No. 17.

An ordinance requiring a license for shows, and providing for a penalty for failure or refusing to obtain one before performance.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Couperville, Washington:

1. That all shows, except as otherwise provided herein, shall pay a license fee of \$5.00, for each and every performance given in the town of Couperville, Washington, said fee to be paid to the town clerk before each and every performance is given.

2. That all shows given where medicines, or other goods or wares are sold, or offered for sale, shall pay a license fee of \$0.50, for each and every performance given in the town of Couperville, Washington, said fee to be paid to the town clerk before each and every performance is given.

3. Provided that nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to include entertainments given under the auspices of any church, educational or benevolent society of said town of Couperville.

4. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$25.00, or be imprisoned in the town jail not to exceed (10) Ten days.

5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval and publication according to law.
