An Ordinance declaring an emergency and providing for the appropriation of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for the street fund for capital outlay,

Whereas, due to improvements in the Town of Coupeville, it could not be foreseen at the time of making the 1962 budget it has become necessary to surface and improve additional streets in the Town of Coupeville, and

Whereas, there are funds on hand for this purpose, it is hereby ordained by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, that an emergency exists of the character enumerated in R. C. W. 35.27.470 and that the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated for use in the city streets under the budgeted item of capital outlay. The funds herein authorized are to be paid from unappropriated funds on hand.
