Ordinance No. 16.

An ordinance requiring a license for a poolroom and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Couperville, Washington

1. It shall be unlawful to conduct a poolroom in the town of Couperville, Washington, without first having obtained a license from the town clerk to operate the same.

2. Any person or persons conducting a poolroom as aforesaid shall pay an annual license fee of \$5.00.

3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall pay a fine not exceeding the sum of \$25.00, or be imprisoned in the town jail not to exceed ten days.

4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval and publication according to law.
