

ORDINANCE NO. 164

1  
2 An Ordinance amending that part of Ordinance No. 79 , as it pertains  
3 to the location of garbage cans and the rates to be charged for garbage collection.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE,  
5 WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

6           Section 1: Section 5 of Ordinance No. 79 is hereby amended to read  
7 as follows: "Section 5: Collections from residences are to be made once each week  
8 and from business houses daily or as often as necessary. All garbage cans are to  
9 be located not more than 15 feet from the curb, street or alley or other right-of-  
10 way suitable for holding the weight of the truck and its load measured as the collector  
11 would walk. No can shall be located inside a building or an enclosed yard that  
12 would require the opening of any door or gate by the collector, and the pathway  
13 leading to the garbage can from the street, alley, etc. , shall be level and main-  
14 tained in good condition.

16           Section 2: Section 6 of Ordinance No. 79 is hereby amended to read  
17 as follows: The rates for garbage and refuse service in residential areas shall be  
18 as follows:

- 20           (a) For one can located accessably as defined in Section 5 not requiring  
21 the collector to ascend or descend a stairway of more than two (2) steps \$1.00 per  
22 month.  
23           (b) For one can, the location of which requires the ascending or descen-  
24 ding of a stairway of more than two (2) steps, \$2.00 per month.  
25           (c) For each can that does not comply with the location as set forth in  
26 Section 5, \$2.00 per month.  
27           (d) For each additional can whose location does not comply with the re-  
28 quirements as set forth in Section 5, the rates set forth in this section for the  
29 first can.  
30           (e) For each additional can whose location complies with the requirements  
31 of Section 5, same as the base rate.

32           Section 3: This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its passage  
and publication as required by law.
