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ORDINANCE NO. 169

An Ordinance providing for the extension of water lines within the
Town limits for the Town of Coupeville and providing for charges to reimburse
the Town for the extension;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington

Section 1: Whenever an extension of the existing water mains is contemplated to supply water to property within the town limits, the Town may extend the water lines provided that there are sufficient prospective users of the water main who have agreed in writing to make service connections thereto at the rate hereinafter specified which will pay for 50 % of the Town's actual cost of installation as may be determined by the Town Council. To obtain a service connection on any main extended under the provisions of this Ordinance, each property owner shall pay a cost of \$1.50 per foot for the property owned by him and abutting on the street in which the main is installed. This charge shall apply to each side of the street. If a water line runs on both sides of a lot situated at an intersection, then no charge shall be made for the distance along the side lot line, however, this distance might not exceed 50 feet. All connections made to the line after it is installed shall be at the same rate for the property served by the water connection. In addition to the above charge, all persons making service connections shall pay the regular hook-up fee and the monthly charge as provided in Ordinance No. 95, or as the same may be amended.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as provided by law.
