

ORDINANCE NO. 178

An Ordinance of the Town of Coupeville creating a payroll fund;

Whereas, it has been determined that a payroll fund would simplify bookkeeping, and it is anticipated that this system will be used in the succeeding calendar year,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the Town of Coupeville, Washington as follows:

Section 1: As authorized by RCW 35.21.085, it is hereby created a "payroll fund" into which money may be placed from time to time as may be directed by the Town Council from any funds available and upon which warrants may be drawn and cashed for the purpose of paying any money due town employees for salaries and wages. The account shall be kept so that it will show the amounts of the payment and the department to which it is properly chargeable.

Section 2: This ordinance shall become effective after its passage and publication as provided by law.
