

ORDINANCE NO. 177

An Ordinance pertaining to municipal elections and caucuses in the Town of Coupeville and repealing ordinances in conflict therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, as follows:

Section 1: That the municipal elections for the Town of Coupeville shall be held on the dates provided in the laws of the State of Washington and conducted according to the laws of said state pertaining thereto.

Section 2: Candidates for town officials shall be nominated at a caucus to be held in the city council chambers or such other auditorium at which the meeting may be adjourned after the same is convened. Said caucus meeting shall be held at a time set by the Town council and notice thereof shall be published once in a newspaper having a general circulation within the County at least ten (10) days prior to the date thereof.

Section 3: The Town Clerk shall at least thirty five (35) days prior to the date set by state law for municipal elections submit to the auditor a certified list of the candidates. The Island County Auditor is hereby appointed ex-officio supervisor of elections of the Town of Coupeville.

Section 4: Ordinance No. 63 and all ordinances in conflict therewith is hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as required by law.
