

ORDINANCE NO. 192

An Ordinance to prevent children and minors, under the age of 18 years, from loitering upon the streets of Coupeville or in other public places or unsupervised places in the Town of Coupeville during certain hours.

THE TOWN COUNCIL of the Town of Coupeville do ordain as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of 18 years to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, or play in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds, wharves, docks or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement, entertainment and eating places and vacant lots, or other unsupervised places in the town of Coupeville between the following hours:

10:30 p.m. Sunday to 5:30 a.m. Monday;
10:30 p.m. Monday to 5:30 a.m. Tuesday;
10:30 p.m. Tuesday to 5:30 a.m. Wednesday;
10:30 p.m. Wednesday to 5:30 a.m. Thursday;
10:30 p.m. Thursday to 5:30 a.m. Friday;
1:00 a.m. Saturday to 5:30 a.m. Sunday;
1:00 a.m. Sunday to 5:30 a.m. Sunday;

provided, however, that the provisions of this section do not apply to a minor accompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand of legitimate business and directed by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, and that legitimate business shall include returning directly home from any school function, work, recreational activity, or properly supervised recreation.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for the parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of eighteen years to knowingly permit such minor to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, or play in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds, wharves, docks, or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement, entertainment and eating places, vacant lots, or other unsupervised places in the Town of Coupeville, between the hours as set forth in Section 1, of this ordinance, provided, however, that the provisions of this section do not apply when the minor is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person have the care and custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his or her parent, guardian or other adult having the care and custody of the minor and said legitimate business shall include returning directly home from any school function, work, recreational activity, or properly supervised recreation.

Section 3: Any minor under the age of eighteen years violating the provisions of Section 1 shall be dealt with in accordance with Juvenile Court laws and procedure, and if remanded for Coupeville police court prosecution, upon conviction shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars or be imprisoned in the city jail for not more than thirty days.

Section 4: Any parent, guardian or other adult having the care and custody of a minor under the age of eighteen years, and who violates Section 2 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the city jail for

not more than thirty days, or both.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as provided by law.
