An Ordinance declaring an emergency and appropriating the total sum of \$5,200.00 to the budget item Capital outlay, Water and Repairs.

Whereas, the exact cost of a well that was to be dug this year could not have been determined at the time of making the 1968 budget,

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Coupeville that:

Section 1: An emergency exists of the character enumerated in RCW 35.33.090 in that it was necessary to drill deeper than anticipated and the sum of \$4,500.00 is hereby appropriated under the classification "water capital outlay". \$3,300.00 of this has come from water reserve and \$1200.00 is from funds otherwise unappropriated. There have also been repairs that were larger than anticipated at the time of making the 1968 budget that are of the character enumerated in RCW 35.33.090 which were necessary for the continued operation of the water system and the additional sum of \$700.00 is appropriated to the classification water-repair and maintenance, from funds otherwise unappropriated.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication.

INTRODUCED November 11, 1968 and Passed December 9, 1968 by a vote of one more than a majority of the council.
