

ORDINANCE NO. 147

An Ordinance changing certain zoning in the Town of Coupeville.

Whereas, a petition has been filed and notice given according to law,

AND

Whereas, the Planning Commission has approved the rezoning requested herein, and a public hearing has been held this date:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, as follows:

Section 1: The following described property is hereby rezoned to a
ME Classification:

A tract of land in the John Alexander Donation Land Claims Nos. 48 and 57 Sections 4 and 33, Townships 31 and 32 North, Range 1, East of the W. M., described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of that certain tract of land conveyed to Daniel Pearson by deed recorded in Vol 2 of Deeds, page 283, Records of Island County, Washington, which is on the East line of said Alexander DLC 3427.22 feet South of the northeast corner of said claim; thence West 561.00 feet to the true p. o. b. of this description; thence South 945 feet; thence East 445 feet to true point of beginning, containing approximately 10 acres.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as required by law.
