

An Ordinance annexing the hereinafter described property to the Town of Coupeville;

Whereas, a petition has been filed with the Town of Coupeville asking for the annexation of the following described property to the Town of Coupeville, Island County, Washington, and

Whereas, a hearing was set for this date at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m. and at said hearing there being no objections to said annexation:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Coupeville as follows:

Section 1: That a petition has been filed requesting the annexation of the following described property to the Town of Coupeville, Island County, Washington:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 3 Block 19 of Alexanders Glenwood Plat of Coupeville, thence South 294.12 feet; thence East 104 feet; thence North 100 feet; thence 16 feet; thence North to the South line of Lot 3 Block 19 of said Alexanders Glenwood Plat of Coupeville; thence West to point of beginning.

That the petition is property signed by owners of more than 75 per cent in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation for the property for which annexation is petitioned and provides that the property to be annexed assume its pro-rata share of the Town's debt and in all other respects comply with RCW 35:13:130

Section 2: That a review board has been called and that its report is favorable.

Section 3: That proper notice of this hearing has been given.

Section 4: It is ordained and ordered that the above described property situated in the County of Island, State of Washington and contiguous to the Town of Coupeville be and the same is hereby annexed to and incorporated to the Town of Coupeville as of the 14th day of April, 1969, and all property in said annexed area be property in the Town of Coupeville and assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as other property in the Town of Coupeville is assessed and taxed to pay for any of the outstanding indebtedness of the Town of Coupeville existing on said date.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as required by law.
