

An ordinance providing for a bond for the town Marshal, and fixing the amount and conditions thereof.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Couperville, Washington:

Sec. 1: That the town Marshall of the town of Couperville, Washington, shall execute and deliver to said town a bond in the sum of \$100.00, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties as such Marshall, and for the turning over to the town Treasurer of said town, all moneys collected by him as such Marshall, and also all moneys collected or received by him by virtue of his duties as ex-officio tax and license collector, said bond to be approved by Mayor of said town.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication according to law in the Island County Times
