

Ordinance No. 23.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Couperville, Washington:

1. That the annual election for the town of Couperville, Washington, shall be on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in December of each year, and said election shall be opened at nine o'clock in the morning, and shall continue until six o'clock in the afternoon of the same day.

2. Said election shall be held at the Court Room in the Court House in said town of Couperville, Washington, and the Board of Election shall consist of one inspector and two judges, who shall be appointed by the town council of said town of Couperville, Washington at their first regular meeting in November of each year.

3. Notice of said election shall be given by the town council at least twenty days preceding such election and signed by the clerk which notice shall be posted on the door of the Court House in Couperville, Washington, and shall be published once in the official paper of said town.

4. Said notice shall be substantially in the following form:

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th day of December, 1910, next at the Court Room in the Court House at Couperville, Washington, an election will be held for said town of Couperville, Washington, at which time the following officers will be elected for said town, (Name the officers) which election will be opened at nine o'clock in the morning and will continue open until six o'clock in the afternoon of said day.

5. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its approval and publication according to law.
