

Ordinance # 25.

An ordinance levying the general taxes for the town of Coupeville, Wash- ington for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of January 1912, on all the taxable property, both real and personal, in said town subject to taxation therein, for the purpose of raising revenue to carry on the different departments of said town for the ensuing fiscal year, prescribing and apportioning the same among the different funds of said town, for said fiscal year and providing for the collection thereof.

Whereas, on the 14th day of August, 1911, the Town Council of said town did duly and regularly adopt an estimate of the money required to meet the public expenses of said town for the ensuing year, and the amount to be raised by taxation in said town for the ensuing year, and the estimated amount of receipts for the ensuing year from sources other than by direct taxation, and,

Whereas, said estimate, together with the notice that said Town Council would meet on the first Monday in October, 1911, at the court house in said town at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m. of said day, for the purpose of hearing objection to or approval of said estimate, and for the purpose of levying said tax, was published for two consecutive weeks in the Island County Times, the official newspaper of said town, as required by law, and,

Whereas, said time for considering said estimate and tax levies has now arrived, and said Town Council having heard all tax payers appearing in favor of or against said proposed levy, does hereby make, determine and decide that the amount of taxes to be levied upon current assessment rolls to be the amount of \$800,000, apportioned as hereinafter set out.

Now, Therefore, Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Soufalle, Washington:

1. That there be and is hereby levied upon the taxable real and personal property in the Town of Soufalle, Washington, subject to taxation therein, a general property tax for municipal purposes for the ensuing fiscal year, commencing January 1, 1912, of \$ 800.00,
2. Said tax shall be apportioned to the various funds of said year as follows:
 1. Park Fund 880.00
 2. Current Expense Fund. 310.00
 3. Road and Street Fund. 410.00
3. That the Town Clerk be, and he is hereby directed to certify to the County Auditor, by County Assessor, and County Treasurer, a copy of this ordinance in compliance with law, and in order that the same may be extended upon the general assessment roll of said county in the same manner and at the same time that the levy for state and county purposes is extended.
4. That said tax shall be collected and paid in to the county treasurer at the time and in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Washington, relating to the collection of taxes in cities of the third and fourth classes.
5. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its approval and publication according to law.
