

Ordinance # 26.

An ordinance requiring a license for moving picture shows and providing a penalty for failure or refusal to obtain one before performance.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Coupeville, Washington:

1. That all moving picture shows shall pay a license fee of one dollar for each and every performance given in the town of Coupeville, Washington, said fee to be paid to the town Treasurer before any performance is given.

2. Provided, that any person paying to the town Treasurer the sum of six dollars shall be entitled to a license permitting him to give any number of moving picture shows during a period of three months, and upon the payment of ten dollars, shall be entitled to a license permitting him or her to give any number of moving picture shows for a period of six months.

3. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$25.00 or be imprisoned in town jail not exceeding ten days.

4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval and publication according to law.
