

Ordinance # 28.

An ordinance levying the general taxes for the town of Coupeville, Washington, for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of January, A. D. 1915, on all the taxable property, both real and personal, in said Town subject to taxation therein, for the purpose of raising revenue to carry on the different departments of said town for the ensuing fiscal year, prescribing and proportioning the same among the different funds of the ^{said} town, for said fiscal year, and providing for the collection thereof.

Whereas, on the thirty first day of August, 1914, the Town Council of the town of Coupeville, Washington, did duly, legally and regularly adopt an estimate of the amount of money required to meet the public expenses of said town for the ensuing year and the amount to be raised by taxation on the taxable property in said town for that year, and the estimated amount of the receipts for the ensuing year from sources other than direct taxation; and

Whereas, the time for considering said estimates ~~and tax~~ and tax levies has now arrived, and said Town Council, having heard all taxpayers appearing in favor of or against said proposed tax levies, does hereby make, determine and decide that the amount of taxes to be levied upon the current assessment rolls to be the sum of five hundred sixty five and 71-100 dollars, (\$ 6 5 . 7 1), ~~apportioned~~ as hereinafter described.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained By
The Town Council Of Town Of Coupeville
Washington:

1. That there be and hereby is levied upon the taxable real and personal property, in the town of Coupeville, Washington, subject to taxation therein, a general property tax for municipal purposes for the ensuing year, commencing January first A. D. 1915, of Five Hundred Sixty-five and 71-100 Dollars.
2. Said tax shall be apportioned to the various funds of said town for said year as follows:

Park Fund	\$56.57
Current Expense fund	\$75.89
Road and Street fund	\$433.25

3. That the Town Clerk be, and be hereby is directed to certify to the County Auditor, County Assessor and County Treasurer, of Island County, Washington each a copy of this ordinance in compliance with law, and in order that said levy may be extended upon the general assessment rolls of said County, in the same manner and at the same time that the levy for State and County purposes is extended.
4. That said tax shall be collected and paid into the County Treasury, of Island County, Washington, at the time and in the manner provided by the law of the State of Washington relating to the collection of taxes in cities of the fourth class.
5. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its approval and publication according to law.
