

Ordinance No. 3.

An ordinance to impose and collect an annual license for dogs, and providing for killing all dogs found at large and not licensed.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Couperville, Washington  
Sec. 1. That there shall be an annual license tax on all dogs allowed to run at large in the town of Couperville, Washington, as follows:  
For all female dogs the license fee shall be the sum of two Dollars annually.  
For all male dogs the license fee shall be the sum of one Dollar annually.

Sec. 2. Such license may be procured from the town marshal, and shall be evidenced by a tag which shall be attached to a collar on all dogs allowed to run at large, said tag to be furnished by said town marshal.

Sec. 3. Any dog found running at large without a license tag as aforesaid shall be killed by town marshal.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication according to law in the Island County Times
