

Ordinance No 33.

An ordinance levying the general taxes for the Town of Coupeville, Washington, for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of January, 1916, and providing for its collection and apportionment:

Whereas, on the 2nd day of September, 1915 the Town Council did duly and regularly prepare and estimate budget of the contemplated financial transaction of the Town of Coupeville for the ensuing fiscal year and to be raised by taxation therein: and

Whereas, said estimated budget together with a notice, in due form, that all persons interested in said estimated budget, would, at a time named in said notice, be given an opportunity for a full and complete discussion of the matters set forth in said estimated budget; and

Whereas, the time for considering said estimated budget having now arrived, and said council having heard all taxpayers and persons interested in said budget who appeared and it appearing to said Council that said budget should be adopted as estimated.

Now, Therefore:

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington:

1, That there be and hereby is levied upon the taxable real and personal property in the Town of Coupeville, Washington, a general property tax for municipal purposes for the ensuing year of \$59.15:

2, Said tax shall be apportioned to the various funds of said year as follows:

Road and street fund	\$274.24
Park fund	55.91
Current expense	224.00

3. That the Town Clerk be and he is hereby directed to certify to the County Auditor, the County Assessor and the County Treasurer a copy of this ordinance in compliance with law, and in order that the same maybe extended upon the general assessment roll of said Island County, in the same manner and at the same time that the

for state and county purposes as is levied.
4, That said tax shall be collected and paid in the County Treasury at the time and in the manner provided by the laws of State of Washington, for the use and benefit of said Town.

5, This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

Ordinance No. 34

An ordinance prohibiting the hunting or killing of game within the incorporate limits of the Town of Coupeville, Island County, Washington, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof:

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington:

That it shall be unlawful for any person, within the incorporated limits of the Town of Coupeville, Island County, Washington, to hunt, pursue, kill, injure or destroy any species of quail, or any species of upland game birds within said incorporated limits, and any one found doing so shall be adjudged guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars or more than one hundred dollars for each offense, or imprisonment in the city jail for a period of not less than ten days or more than thirty days, or by both fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.
