

Ordinance No. 39

An Ordinance Assessing the cost of construction
of a sidewalk against the Property Immediately
Abutting thereon

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of
Couperville, Washington:—

Section 1. That the sidewalk constructed by the Superintendent of Streets of the Town of Couperville, Washington, in pursuance of the Resolution passed and adopted February 23rd, A. D. 1926, by the Council of said Town, benefits in the sum of \$96.00, the hereinafter described real property immediately abutting upon said sidewalk, which real property is more particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 798 feet East of the Northwest corner of Block 13, in Thomas Couper's Plat of Couperville, and running thence East 300 feet; thence North to the South side of the Road there running Easterly and Westerly; thence Westerly along the South side of said road to a point due North of the point of beginning; and thence South to the point of beginning, being a part of the Thomas Couper Donation claim, in Island County, State of Washington.

Section 2. That the cost of the construction of said sidewalk is the sum of \$96.00, and the said cost of construction, in the sum of \$96.00, is hereby assessed and made a lien on the above described ^{real} property.

Section 3. That the aforesaid assessment shall become due and payable on the first Monday in the month of February, A. D. 1927, and shall, by the County Treasurer of Island County, Washington, be entered on the general Tax rolls of said County, against the aforesaid real property, and shall become delinquent, draw interest and be collected, at the time and in the manner provided by law for the collection of the County Taxes of said Island County for the year 1926.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
