

## Ordinance No. 4

An ordinance defining assault, and assault and battery, and providing a penalty therefor.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Coupeville, Washington:

Sec. 1. Every person who shall, in an angry or threatening manner, attempt to strike, beat or wound another in the town of Coupeville, Washington, shall be guilty of assault, and upon conviction thereof shall pay a fine of not to exceed \$100.00, or be imprisoned in the town jail for not to exceed 60 Days

Sec. 2. Every person who shall strike, beat or wound another in the town of Coupeville, Washington, shall be deemed guilty of assault and battery, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$100.00, or be imprisoned in the town jail not to exceed 60 days.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication according to law in the Island County Times.
