

Ordinance No 40.

An Ordinance, granting to the Union Oil Company of California, a corporation, its successors and assigns, permission to locate, erect, operate and maintain a warehouse or tanks, or both for the storage, sale and distribution of petroleum and its products on a tract of land known as Block Eight (8) of Keister's Alteration Plat of Alexander's Glenwood, Island County, Washington, according to plat recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, at Page 6 1/2 records of said county situated in Island County, State of Washington.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, as follows:

Section 1 The Union Oil Company of California, a corporation having asked permission to locate, erect, operate and maintain a warehouse or tanks, or both, for the storage, sale and distribution of petroleum and its products on a tract of land known as Block Eight (8), of Keister's Alteration Plat of Alexander's Glenwood, Island County, Washington, according to plat recorded in Volume 2, of Plats, at Page 6 1/2 records of said county, situated in Island County, State of Washington, and the said request being favorably considered by the Council of said town, it is hereby ordained and permission is hereby given and granted the Union Oil Company of California, a corporation its successors and assigns, to locate, erect, operate and maintain a warehouse or tanks, or both, for the storage, sale and distribution of petroleum and its products on the tract of land hereinbefore described.

Section 2 The said Union Oil Company of California, a corporation, shall bear all costs incidental to the passage and publication of this Ordinance.

Section 3 This ordinance shall be of full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
