

ORDINANCE No. 45

AN ORDINANCE to establish and maintain a free public Library, providing for the levy and collection of taxes for that purpose, creating a library fund, and providing for the appointment of a board of trustees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE, WASHINGTON.

Section 1. That by vote of its common Council it is hereby ordained that there be and is hereby established and there shall hereafter be maintained in and by the Town of Coupeville, Washington, by itself, a free public library in conformity with law.

Section 2. That annual appropriation for the maintenance and support of such free public library shall be levied and collected yearly as provided by law.

Section 3. That there be and is hereby created a fund to be known as the LIBRARY FUND, into which shall be paid all taxes and other funds collected, given, donated, contributed, accepted or received for such library.

Section 4. That the Mayor of the Town of Coupeville be and he is hereby authorized and empowered, with the consent of the Town Council, to appoint a board of five trustees who shall have the management and control of said library as provided by law.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its approval and publication according to law.
