

AN ORDINANCE providing for the issuance of warrants to pay the cost of extending and enlarging the water works system of the Town of Coupeville and providing a fund for the payment of such warrants.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to issue warrants to pay the cost of extending for a considerable distance the mains in the east and west ends of Town and to increase the size of the main running south to the city limits for the purpose of making it possible to later provide water service and fire protection for the town schools.

SECTION 2: That the warrants above specified shall bear interest at the rate of 6% per annum and be payable out of the revenues of the water system of said Town of Coupeville and the entire gross revenues of said water system, over and above the amounts heretofore pledged for the payment of the principal and interest of the water revenue bonds heretofore issued to pay for said water system and over and above the reasonable cost of maintenance and operation of said system, are hereby pledged to the payment of said warrants.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its publication, as provided by law.
