

ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE fixing and establishing the rates to be charged for water furnished by the municipal water system.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The monthly rates for the use of water, other than that measured by meter, are hereby fixed as follows:

Minimum rate, per month, \$2.25

The rates for water supply through meters are hereby fixed as follows:

For the first eight hundred cubic feet, or less, used each month, 2.25.

For the next one thousand cubic feet, per hundred cubic feet, .15

For water in excess of one thousand eight hundred cubic feet, per hundred cubic feet, .10

The foregoing rates are applicable to service within the corporate limits of the Town of Coupeville. The charge for service outside the said limits shall be twenty five cents (\$.25) greater for each month.

Section 2. All water rents shall be due and payable at the office of the Town Treasurer on or before the last day of the month for all charges for water furnished during the preceding month. If the same be not paid when due, the Town Treasurer shall give notice that the water account is delinquent and shall set a date, not less than ten days nor more than twenty days after the giving of notice, upon which date the water shall be shut off and the meter shall be removed if the account is not paid. An additional charge of one dollar (\$1) shall be assessed and collected for turning on water which has been out off under the provisions of this section.

Section 3. A rebate of twenty five cents (\$.25) shall be allowed on the total amount of each bill for water rental (beginning with the bills rendered September 1, 1937), provided the bill is paid not later than the tenth day of the month in which it is due.

Section 4. The charge for service for water furnished the fire hydrants shall be as fixed by the Town Council each year in the annual Town Budget.

7 Section 5. Temporary modifications of and individual exceptions to the provisions of this Ordinance may be made by unanimous action of the Town Council.

Section 6. Ordinances Nos. 47 and 50 of the Town of Coupeville, being inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in effect on and after the first day of August following its passage, approval, and publication according to law.
