

Ordinance No. 6^v

An ordinance providing for a bond for the town Treasurer, and fixing the amount and conditions thereof.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Couperville, Washington:

Sec. 1. That the town treasurer of the town of Couperville, Washington shall execute and deliver to said town, a bond in the sum of \$1000.00, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties as such treasurer, and the turning over to said town of Couperville, Washington, at the expiration of his term of office, all money collected or received by him as such treasurer, not paid out under authority of law, but remaining in his hands as such treasurer.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publications according to law in the Island County Times.
