

AN ORDINANCE fixing rates for sewage service, providing for the collection thereof, providing for penalties and liens and the enforcement thereof in case of failure to pay the said rates.

WHEREAS, the Town of Coupeville has let a contract for the construction of certain additions to its sewer system and is about to issue special indebtedness bonds against the revenues thereof and it is necessary to fix rates and charges for sewage service and provide for the collection thereof,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE, as follows:

Section 1. A service charge of fifty cents per month is hereby fixed for sewage service for each and every connection now made with the present sewer system to be made therewith, and for each and every connection to be made to any additions to the present sewer system; each building to be considered a separate connection.

Section 2. All of the foregoing charges for service shall be paid in advance for the current month on or before the 10th day of each calendar month, and, if not so paid, there shall be a penalty of ten per cent added thereto, and the whole sum shall bear interest at the rate of 8% per annum until paid.

Section 3. All charges for connection and for sewage service provided for in this ordinance together with penalties and interest shall be a lien upon the property with which such connection is made and sewage service rendered respectively, and, if not paid within sixty days after the date of delinquency, shall be certified by the town treasurer to the county treasurer of island county, Washington. as a ;~~see~~ 1990.

lien upon such property respectively, as provided for in Paragraph 9198-7 of Remington's Revised Statutes and shall be subject to foreclosure pursuant to the terms of said section.

Section 4. Such person as shall from time to time under authority of the Town Council of the Town of Coupeville act as water superintendent for the said Town shall act also as superintendent of sewers and shall supervise the collection of, and payment into the hands of the Town Treasurer, all the rates and charges accruing from time to time as herein provided for, and all such sums when collected shall be paid by the said Town Treasurer into the fund which is entitled "Coupeville 1939 Sewer Revenue Fund."
