

ORDINANCE No. 66

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF DALE STREET

In the matter of the petition of G.H. Farmer and others for the vacation of a portion of Dale Street as platted in Alexander's Plat of Glenwood, Coupeville, Island County, Washington.

WHEREAS a duly verified petition has been filed with the said Town Council, by one G.H. Farmer and other, being freeholders of portions of Alexander's Plat of Glenwood, Coupeville, Island County, Washington, asking that certain portions of said plat, to-wit: That a portion of DALE STREET, being its extent from Coveland Street 200 feet South, in width being 66 feet, be vacated as by law provided; and

WHEREAS; said written petition was duly filed with this Town Council on the 11th day of May, 1943, and that thereupon on said date said Council by resolution fixed a date certain for the hearing on said petition, which time was not more than 60 days nor less than 20 days after the date of such resolution and the passage of the same, and that notice of the hearing on said petition was given by the Town Clerk as by law provided, and all as more fully appears from the records and journal of this Town Council; and whereas

WHEREAS; The said Town Council has heard arguments for and in behalf of said petition to vacate and there appeared no one in objection to the same; and the said Council being satisfied that the asked for vacation would be to the best interests of the public in general and that it would not burden or inconvenience any property or any person in said plat or the traveling public in general, said street having never been improved or opened to public use, and only a small section of said street, as hereinafter described, being desired for retention for future projected street purposes; and

WHEREAS; it is evident that there are no damages, either general or special, resulting to any property owner as a result of said vacation, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, that a portion of DALE STREET, Being that portion which is south of Coveland Street, as the same appears of record in the plat of Alexander's Plat of Glenwood, in Coupeville, Island County, Washington, being a street 200 feet long by 66 feet in width, be and the same is hereby vacated; with the express provision and exception, that there be and is retained for street purposes that section hereinafter de

scribed, which is reserved to be dedicated as a part of an easterly extension of Race Street, to-wit: That portion bounded by a line as follows: Beginning at a point 61.2 feet north of the Southwest corner of Lot 5, Block 4, thence West 66 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 8, Block 2, thence 10 feet north, thence in a straight line to the point of beginning; thence being a tract comprising 342.6 square feet, more or less, retained for street purposes and excepted from the vacation of the southern portion of Dale Street.
