

ORDINANCE No. 67

AN ORDINANCE licensing pin ball machines and games of skill machines within the corporate limits of the Town of Coupeville.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the Town of Coupeville:

Section 1. That the monthly license fee for each pin ball machine or game of skill machine shall be \$3.00 per month, payable in advance.

Section 2. That the possession and display or use of such pin ball or game of skill machine, without the possession and display of lawful license for the same, such license to be plainly displayed on or in close proximity to the said machine, shall constitute misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$300, each violation of this ordinance to be considered a separate offense.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect on the 1st day of July, following publication.

ORDINANCE No. 37.

An ordinance licensing pin ball machines and games of skill machines within the corporate limits of the Town of Coupeville.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington:

Sec. 1. That the monthly license fee for each pin ball machine or game of skill machine shall be \$3.00 per month, payable in advance.

Sec. 2. That the possession and display or use of such pin ball or game of skill machine, without the possession and display of a lawful license for the same, such license to be plainly displayed on or in close proximity to the said machine, shall constitute a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not exceeding \$300, each violation of this ordinance to be considered a separate offense.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect on the 1st day of July following publication.
