

ORDINANCE

No. 68.

An ordinance pertaining to civilian defense.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, that, during the existence of war in which the United States is engaged, the Council shall have power to perform any act necessary or suitable for civilian defense, either by itself or by agreement with other municipal bodies, and may confer such power upon its proper officers and employees; and it shall have power to levy taxes, incur indebtedness, and make expenditures of funds for civilian defense purposes; all by lawful resolution of the Council, and all to the full extent of authority granted to the Town by the State of Washington.

It is declared that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall become effective on and after the date of its passage.
