

ORDINANCE No. 75.

Relating to the water supply system.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, that the following policies of the Water Department of the said town are hereby established and published:-

1. Rates for water rentals are as listed in Ordinance No. 58, and will be impartially enforced.

2. A separate meter will be used at, ~~or a separate~~ *m. n. n.* ~~minimum charge collected for~~, each separate residence or business establishment.

3. Extensions of water service outside the town limits shall be subject to requirements as follows:

(a) The whole costs of extensions shall be paid by the water users, and all installations from the town's water mains up to and including the individual meters shall become the property of the town.

(b) Sufficient money to cover the cost of any such extension shall be collected, and plans and specifications for the project shall be submitted to and approved by the Town Council, prior to the start of any new installation for water service.

(c) Each customer desiring connection to and service from such extension after the time of its original installation shall pay a proportionate share of the cost of original installation, such share to be determined by the Town Council, and the money so paid shall belong to the water fund of the Town.

(d) Every new customer shall pay a hookup charge of twenty five dollars, or the actual cost of hookup by installation of a water meter and connection to water mains, whichever amount is the greater.

4. This ordinance is effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
