

ORDINANCE No. 76-B

RELATING TO THE NAMES OF STREETS

1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE THAT THE NAMES OF STREETS AS THEY APPEAR IN THE SEVERAL PLATS, as recorded in the office of the Auditor of Island County, Washington which plats or parts of plats, together with unplatted areas, comprise the site of the present Town of Coupeville, shall be and are the names of the respective streets in the Town of Coupeville; except for platted streets or parts of streets which have been vacated, and except for new names and for changes of names hereinafter described, as follows: -

(a) The unplatted street which extends southeasterly from the junction of Coveland and Main Streets to First Street is hereby confirmed as an established street and is named Coveland Street.

(b) The unplatted street (lying partially without the town limits but wholly within right of way owned by the Town) which extends northeasterly from the eastern end of Race Street (as platted) to the junction of Colburn and Coveland Streets is hereby confirmed as an established street and is named Race Street.

(c) The unplatted extension of Leach Street northerly and northeasterly from Earnest Street is hereby confirmed as an established street and is named Leach Street.

(d) The Street, commonly known as Front Street, which is designated in Alexander's Plat of Glenwood as County Road, extending westerly from Main Street to Broadway, is hereby named Front Street.

(e) The following named or described streets, which extend easterly from First Street in Cranney's Addition to Coupeville to a junction with Leach Street, are hereafter part of one street, named First Street, and former different names are discontinued, viz.: the unplatted street connecting First Street in the said Cranney's Addition with Whitecomb Street; and all that part of Whitecomb Street which is south of the north boundary of Farnsworth Street in the Academy Addition to the Town of Coupeville; and all of Farnsworth Street.

(f) The names of certain streets in certain described recorded plats are hereby changed, and their new names are hereby declared to be the official and correct names of such streets in the incorporated Town of Coupeville, viz.:

(In Alexander's Plat of Glenwood and in Keister's Alteration Plat of Alexander's Glenwood.)

First Street is changed to Holbrook Street; Second Street (including its unplatted extension west of Grace Street) is changed to Calhoun Street; Third Street is changed to Libbey Street.

(In the Plat of the Town of Coupeville as platted

as platted by Thomas Coupe)

First East Street is changed to Center Street; Second East Street is changed to Haller Street; Third East Street is changed to Kinney Street; Fourth East Street is changed to Clapp Street; Fifth East Street is changed to Gould Street.
(In the Plat of Hull's Addition to Coupeville.)

North Street is changed to Lovejoy Street; South Street is changed to Cranney Street; Middle Street is changed to Hull Street.

2. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the date of its publication according to law; provided, that the names of streets as newly designated herein shall not be deemed to change duly recorded plats, for the legal description of real property in such plats; and provided further, that the word "street" as used herein shall be liberally construed, the intent being that any lack of a complete and accurate description in this ordinance of any street shall not invalidate the effect of any part of this ordinance.
