

ORDINANCE NO. 78

AN ORDINANCE Regulating the Use of Streets, Highways and Alleys in the Town of Coupeville, and Providing a Penalty for the Violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, as follows:

SECTION I

Article 1. All vehicles parked on Front Street between Main and Alexander Streets shall be parked in spaces and in directions as marked off by the yellow lines on the pavement.

Article 2. All vehicles parked on the streets except as provided for in the preceding Article shall be parked parallel to the curb.

Article 3. No vehicle shall be parked within fifteen(15) feet of a stop sign or a fire hydrant.

Article 4. No vehicle shall be parked in a drivesay of a Fire Station.

Article 5. No vehicle shall be parked in such a manner as to leave clear less than ten (10) feet of the width of roadway on any street or alley.

SECTION II

Article 1. The speed limit for vehicles on Front Street between Main and Alexander Streets shall be not more than fifteen (15) miles per hour, and in the remainder of the Town, shall not be more than twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

SECTION III

Article 1 Any person convicted of violation of this Ordinance shall be fined in any sum not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50) or shall be imprisoned for fifteen (15) days, or shall suffer both fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance shall be effective on the date of Publication according to law, in the Island County Times, Coupeville, Washington, September 25, 1947.
