

Ordinance no. 8.

An ordinance providing for a street poll tax in the town of Couperville, Washington, and a method for the payment and collecting thereof, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the town council of the town of Couperville, Washington:

1. Every male inhabitant of the town of Couperville, Washington, between the ages of twenty-one and fifty years, shall be and is hereby assessed, and shall annually pay to said town a street poll tax in the sum of two Dollars. The town marshal shall give to every person paying said sum a receipt in full for said tax for such year.

2. Such poll tax shall become due and payable on the 1st day of March of each and every year, and the town marshal of said town is hereby empowered and directed after said date each year to proceed to collect said tax.

3. Said town marshal shall from time to time prepare lists of all persons liable to pay said poll tax, and demand verbally of each and every person so liable to pay the same.

4. Any and all persons liable to pay such poll tax, and who shall refuse to pay the same as herein provided on the request and demand of such town marshal, as provided in this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$10.00.

5. The town of Couperville, Washington, shall have the right to recover in a civil suit in any court of competent jurisdiction, any tax payable under the provisions of this ordinance, or to recover any fine or penalty

which may be imposed herein.
6. This ordinance shall take effect
and be in force from and after its
approval and publication according to
law.
