

ORDINANCE NO. 81

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 8 of Ordinance No. 79 which is an ordinance to protect the health and general welfare and providing for the gathering and disposition of garbage and refuse of the Town of Coupeville, Washington.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COUPEVILLE,  
WASHINGTON:

Section 1. That Section 8, of Ordinance No. 79 of said Town be and it is hereby amended to read as follows: Each house-holder or business firm shall be billed by the Town Treasurer, for garbage disposal service at the rates designated by this Ordinance. The accounts shall be due and payable on the 10th day of the following month and delinquent 10 days thereafter. Upon failure to pay such charges and upon delinquency thereof, the amount shall become a lien against the property for which the garbage collection is rendered. Such lien shall be made effective by filing a notice thereof, specifying the charges, the period covered by the charges and giving a legal description of the premises for which the service was rendered. Such liens shall be filed with the same official and within the time and shall be foreclosed within the time and manner prescribed by the laws of the State of Washington for filing and foreclosing liens for labor and material. Such liens shall be prior to any and all liens and encumbrances filed subsequent to the filing of such lien but shall be subject to all general taxes and local improvements assessments whether levied prior or subsequent thereto.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be enforced and take effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
