ORDINANCE NO. 355F

An Ordinance repealing Coupeville Ordinance No. 313A and amending certain portions of Coupeville Ordinance No. 355A, namely:

PART A, SECTION 4, METER REQUIREMENTS AND SIZES, and

PART A, SECTION 7, INITIAL WATER HOOKUP CHARGES and

PART B, SEWAGE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, as follows:

Ordinance No. 313A is hereby repealed.

The above cited sections of Part A of Ordinance No. 355A are hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4: METER REQUIREMENTS, SIZES, and TYPES

a. Requirements for Meters:

(1) No person shall obtain or attempt to obtain water from the Coupeville Municipal Water System except through a water meter duly registered in the office of the Town Clerk, provided, that this requirement shall not apply to water used for fire fighting, other emergencies, or authorized by the Town Council for specific public purposes.

(2) A separate water meter shall be installed and used for each single family residence, which term shall include garages, outbuildings, and other typical ancillary structures.

(3) A separate water meter shall be installed and used for each commercial or non-residential building, provided, that upon request of the owner or contract purchaser of such properties, more than one meter may be installed and used.

(4) Multi-family residential units shall have one meter installed for each unit, provided, that upon request of the owner or contract purchaser of such properties, fewer meters, but not less than one, may be installed. In such cases, however, the initial hookup charges, as provided in Section 7 below, shall be the equivalent of the amount that would have been due if each unit had its own meter.

b. Size and Types of Meters:

(1) Meter sizes shall conform to those prescribed by the standards of the American Water Works Association, with any interpretations of those standards to be made by the Town Building Inspector.

(2) All meters of a size 2 inches or larger, shall be compound meters.

SECTION 7: INITIAL WATER HOOKUP FEES

a. In-Town Water Hookup Fees: Prospective customers of the Coupeville Municipal Water System shall pay to the Town hookup fees as listed below prior to the installation of meters by the Town and the commencement of water service. These fees are intended to defray capital costs of the water system and are in addition to the costs of the meters and their installation.

METER SIZE	HOOKUP FEE
3/4-5/8 inch	\$ 1,200
1 inch	\$ 3,000
1.5 inch	\$ 6,000
2 inch	\$ 9,600
3 inch	\$19,200
4 inch	\$30,000
6 inch	\$60,000

b. Out-Of-Town Water Hookup Fees: Out-Of-Town hookup fees shall be 200% of the rates prescribed above for In-Town hookups.

Part B, Sewage, of Ordinance No. 355A is hereby amended by the addition of a section as follows:

SECTION 3: INITIAL SEWER HOOKUP FEES

Sewer Hookup Fees: Prospective customers of the Coupeville Sewer System shall pay to the Town initial sewer hookup fees prior to the commencement of sewer service. These fees are intended to defray capital costs of the sewer system and are in addition to the costs of the sewer permit fee. The amount of such fee for any given facility shall be equivalent to the water hookup fee in accordance with Section 7, Part A above.
