

ORDINANCE NO. 374

1 An Ordinance declaring an emergency in the City Street Fund, the Arterial  
2 Street Fund, the Cumulative Equipment Fund, the LID #2 Fund and the Capital  
3 Improvement Fund, and setting forth the amounts and repealing Ordinance No. 368.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of  
5 Coupeville, Washington, as follows:

7 SECTION 1: There is hereby declared to be an emergency in the City Street  
8 Fund for the expenditure of funds for an unappropriated contribution towards  
9 the Urban Arterial Board (N.W. Coveland St. and N.W. Madrona Way) street  
10 construction project which could not have been foreseen at the time of the  
11 making of the estimates for the annual 1984 Budget which requires the  
12 expenditure of \$102,325.00 dollars not provided for in the annual budget.

13 SECTION 2: There is hereby declared to be an emergency in the Arterial  
14 Street Fund for the expenditure of funds for an unappropriated contribution  
15 towards the Arterial Street Fund for the expenditure of funds for an  
16 unappropriated contribution towards the Urban Arterial Board (N.W. Coveland St.  
17 and N.W. Madrona Way) street construction project which could not have been  
18 foreseen at the time of the making of the estimates for the annual 1984 Budget  
19 which requires the expenditure of \$151,800.00 dollars not provided for in the  
20 annual budget.

21 SECTION 3: There is hereby declared to be an emergency in the Cumulative  
22 Equipment Fund for the expenditure of funds for an unappropriated contribution  
23 towards the purchase of a vehicle which could not have been foreseen at the  
24 time of the making of the estimates for the annual 1984 Budget which requires  
25 the expenditure of \$735.00 dollars not provided for in the annual budget.

26 SECTION 4: There is hereby declared to be an emergency in the Local  
27 Improvement District #2 Fund for the expenditure of funds for an unappropriated  
28 contribution towards bond redemption which could not have been foreseen at the  
29 time of the making of the estimates for the annual 1984 Budget which requires  
30 the expenditure of \$500.00 dollars not provided for in the annual budget.

SECTION 5: There is hereby declared to be an emergency in the Capital Improvement Fund for the expenditure of funds for an unappropriated contribution towards the IAC Boat Launch Park Project which could not have been foreseen at the time of the making of the estimates for the annual 1984 Budget which requires the expenditure of \$5,000.00 dollars not provided for in the annual budget.

SECTION 6: The Town of Coupeville, in the person of the Treasurer-Clerk, is hereby authorized to expend for the five said emergencies the total sum of \$260,360.00 dollars to meet the needs of the said emergencies.

SECTION 7: Coupeville Ordinance No. 368 is hereby repealed in its entirety

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage by the Town Council and proper posting according to law.
