

ORDINANCE 381 J

An Ordinance of the Town of Coupeville, Washington amending the Development Regulations as adopted in Ordinance 381, pertaining to the operation of Kennels in the Residential Agriculture District.

WHEREAS, these amendments to the Development Regulations were initiated by the Planning Commission at the request of the Town Council, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a Public Hearing on and recommended adoption of the proposed amendments, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council held a Public Hearing on the amendments on the 23rd day of July, 1990.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Coupeville that:

SECTION 1

Chapter 10.30 of Ordinance No. 381, of the Development Regulations, be amended as follows:

B) Permitted Uses

1) Principal Uses

a) Single Family Dwellings;

b) Agriculture, floriculture, general farming, dairying, poultry raising, stock raising, ~~kennels~~ and other agricultural land uses, buildings and activities, except farms for disposal of garbage and offal by feeding same to livestock;

SECTION 2

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon posting, publishing and recording with the Auditor of Island County, Washington.
