ORDINANCE NO. 419

An Ordinance of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, vacating the portion of right-of-way for Alexander St. described as beginning at the NE corner of Lot 1, Blk 13, Keister's Alteration Plat of Alexander's Glenwood; thence south 65'±; thence east 35'± to the most easterly NE corner of Lot 3, Blk 13; thence northwesterly 74'± to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Coupeville has passed a resolution calling for the vacation of a portion of the right-of-way for Alexander Street, and has held a public hearing on the said issue and the Town Council finds it is in the public interest to vacate the portion of said street and the Town Council has determined that annexing this portion of land to the adjacent site of the proposed public library would be beneficial.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Coupeville, Washington, as follows:

SECTION 1: That portion of Alexander Street, as described, is hereby vacated and said vacated street shall be attached to the piece of land for the proposed public library.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon proper posting and recording with the Auditor of Island County, Washington. PASSED by the Town Council and APPROVED by its Mayor this 22nd day of June, 1987.
